3. Definition

The fertility rate in adolescent women is calculated based on the relationship between the number of live births per 1,000 women to adolescent mothers (women aged 15 to 19 years). It shows fertility behaviour, taking only the female population of adolescent age into account. It is a measure that relates births and the group categorised by age and sex with the highest probability of giving birth (usually defined as women of fertile age, or those aged between 15 and 49 years). This precision allows the potential distortion due to different levels of distribution by age and sex among populations to be eliminated. It is therefore a more precise measure for comparing levels of fertility among populations than the gross birth rate.

4. Calculation formula

5. Reading

The final value of the indicator represents the percentages of adolescent mothers with respect otto the total number of mothers for the same time period.
