3. Definition
An indicator that measures the extent to which the distribution of income within a territory deviates from a perfectly equal distribution.

4. Calculation formula
$= \frac{2}{n} \sum_{k=1}^n (W_k - \mu) \left( \frac{k}{n} - \frac{1}{n^2} \sum_{k=1}^n k \right)$

5. Reading
The Gini index can take a value between 0 and 100. Where 0 implies equal economic distribution and 100 implies maximum economic inequality (where a single person retains the economic totality of a territory).
