3. Definition

It is the ratio between the income of 20% of the population with the highest incomes respect to the income of the 20% of the population with the lowest incomes (the income obtained for the top quintile in relation to that of the lowest quintile).

4. Calculation formula

$$=\frac{Q_{p80}}{Q_{p20}}$$

Where:

- P80 includes the population in the top quintile of the value of income.
- P20 includes the population in the bottom quintile of the value of income.

5. Reading

The Indicator shows inequality in income distribution.

Higher values indicate greater inequality. A value of 1 indicates that the top income quintile (people with the highest income) and the bottom quintile (people with the lowest income) have the same income. A value of 2 indicates that people in the top quintile are paid twice as much as people in the bottom quintile.


